President Moulton welcomed Board members and presented **ITEMS 1 and 2** as follows. On motion by Mayor Nix, seconded by Mr. Langham, **ITEM 1** was unanimously approved.

**RESOLUTION
NAMING OF THE ENGINEERING AND COMPUTING SCIENCES BUILDING**

WHEREAS, United States Senator Richard C. Shelby and Dr. Annette N. Shelby have been longtime, staunch supporters of the University of South Alabama and its academic programs, and

WHEREAS, Senator Shelby and Dr. Shelby, in May 2006, were awarded Honorary Doctorates by the University in recognition of their exemplary leadership, accomplishments, and contributions to higher education, both within the State of Alabama and nationally, and

WHEREAS, due to the diligent efforts of Senator Shelby on behalf of his constituents in the University of South Alabama community, substantial federal funding has been obtained in furtherance of USA's teaching and research missions, and

WHEREAS, the construction of a new classroom and research facility for USA's Engineering and Computing Sciences programs will provide generations of students and faculty expanded opportunities for learning and discovery in a state-of-the-art building, and

WHEREAS, the new facility will advance the University's commitment to preparing students for successful careers in engineering, computing sciences, and related technological fields, and

WHEREAS, Senator Richard C. Shelby and Dr. Annette N. Shelby, merit utmost appreciation and recognition for their extraordinary service to the field of higher education and to the citizens of Alabama,

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NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, the University of South Alabama Board of Trustees approves the naming of Shelby Hall – Engineering and Computing Sciences Building – in honor of Senator Richard C. Shelby and Dr. Annette N. Shelby.

On motion by Mayor Jones, seconded by Mr. Yance, **ITEM 2** was unanimously approved:

**RESOLUTION
 CONSTRUCTION CONTRACT FOR SHELBY HALL - ENGINEERING AND COMPUTING SCIENCES BUILDING**

WHEREAS, the University of South Alabama has a growing enrollment in the College of Engineering and the School of Computer and Information Sciences, and

WHEREAS, the quality of instruction and research is strongly enhanced by excellent facilities, and

WHEREAS, U. S. Senator Richard Shelby was instrumental in securing \$40 million in federal funding for construction of this facility, and

WHEREAS, on June 5, 2008, the Board of Trustees of the University of South Alabama authorized the President to engage the firm of Barganier Davis Sims Architects, Associated, to design this project, and

WHEREAS, the University recently solicited bids for construction of the building, and


WHEREAS, the University was successful in receiving competitive bids from nine pre-qualified construction companies as shown on the attached schedule, and

WHEREAS, on August 18, 2009, the bids were opened, and Elkins Constructors, Inc., of Jacksonville, Florida, submitted the lowest qualified bid in the amount of \$28,854,000,


THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board of Trustees authorizes the University President to execute a contract with the successful low bidder.
